General Description:

Performs duties of a licensed therapist pursuant to their areas of expertise in an outpatient setting, under the direction of the Director of the Counseling Center of the Pastoral Institute.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Provides counseling services to include but not limited to:
 - a. Diagnostic evaluations, assessments and psychosocial histories;
 - b. Treatment planning and conducting psychotherapy using the modalities of individual, group, marital, and family psychotherapy;
 - c. Consultation, referral, education, and advocacy;
 - d. Participates in on-call rotation as required.
 - e. Psychological testing and related reports, if applicable to license and experience.
- 2. Completes and maintains all required documentation, records and written correspondence in accordance with the Institute's guidelines to include but not limited to:
 - Diagnostic evaluations, assessments, psychosocial histories, treatment plans, progress notes, and discharge summaries.
 - b. Participation in Case Management Group.
- 3. Attends required meetings as well as educational and in-service programs.
- 4. Participation in the planning, conduct, and evaluation of the preventive and educational programs of the Pastoral Institute to include:
 - a. Workshops, clinics, or seminars for clergy persons as well as other professionals;
 - b. Community and public educational workshops and seminars
 - c. In-services.
- 5. Performance of general administrative duties to include:
 - a. Participates in public relations services of the Institute as needed.
